About the Appenzeller Huus

At 902 meters above sea level, a contemporary retreat and relaxation area called "Appenzeller Huus" has been under construction since 2023 in the historic town of Gonten. The three-star superior Hotel Huus Bären (20 rooms) and the Hotel Huus Löwen (24 rooms) are already welcoming guests. The five-star Hotel Huus Quell (30 rooms) opening with one of Switzerland's most innovative wellness areas is planned for the first quarter of 2025. In addition to 43 serviced apartments, the new bar "The Botanicum," another restaurant, and the most extensive wine cellar in Switzerland complement the hotel resort. The investor Jan Schoch's motto, "A Wellness Lifestyle Community," is emblazoned across the project.

The gourmet restaurant Bärenstobe welcomes travelers and locals, as do the cozy Löwenstobe, the Lehnerstobe, the Jakob Schlaepfer Lounge, the Appenzellerstöbli, and the tavern.
